Appearance is Everything!

While campaigning, concerns about the appearance of some buildings and properties kept being mentioned. Council heard! Camper violations (campers on empty lots) were identified, warnings were sent to the property owners. The compliance options were discussed and all but one has now complied.

Bylaw infraction inquiries and reports that have come into the office have kept the Bylaw Enforcement Officer busy with warnings being handed out and following up for compliance.

RVSBC joined Communities in Bloom and held the first annual CiB Flower Pot Challenge. What a fun community activity! Three talented, creative people were awarded 1st, 2nd and 3rd place for their flower pots. Winners were determined by community votes.

Improved Boat Launch! A cost-effective new launch, dock and sign were completed, before fishing season started. Council was able to keep the fees the same as prior years for residents and neighbors.

Organized the Community Clean Up on June 11 and 12 and welcome letters being mailed to new property owners.

Both community entrance signs have been repainted and looking good!

Council has lowered the rental rate to make the hall more accessible for everyone who wants to use it.

Council reviewed the garbage and recycle collection costs and determined that Loraas was the most efficient and cost effective. By closely reviewing and monitoring expenses council has saved the following:

Administration costs - \$41,088

Maintenance costs - \$36,882

Contractor costs - \$44,157
