2022 Property Taxes

Your 2022 property tax payment must be in our office no later than Saturday, December 31, 2022 to avoid a 1.5% interest charge added to your tax card on January 1st.

Payment can be made by cheque, cash, etransfer sent to

saskbeach@sasktel.net, or through your bank (Affinity Credit Union, Central 1 Credit Union, BMO, RBC, Scotiabank, and CIBC). Cheques can be dropped off at the Municipal Office through the front door mail slot, or through the mail, **postmarked no later than December 31st**.
