- 152/9/20 Woodley/Galan That Administrator Chouinard will proceed with legal advisement for the pending property purchase request from Nicolas Skulski and the pending subdivision project that would result from the property purchase. This is conditional upon Mr. Skulski signing an agreement with the Resort Village of Saskatchewan Beach (RVSB) that he will reimburse the RVSB the initial legal fees incurred from the legal advisement.
- 153/9/20 Beyer/Woodley That in accordance to resolution "113/8/19: That it is the responsibility of all Resort Village of Saskatchewan Beach property owners to maintain their own driveway even when there is an encroachment on municipal land", the requests from James Marquardt are denied. The driveway and retaining wall are the responsibility of the property owners of Lots 23-24, Block 66, Plan 69R13672 and council will not close the northside of the driveway. CARRIED
- Corey Harper requested to speak to the new council on the Resort Village of Saskatchewan Beach (RVSB) height restriction resolution. Mr. Harper expressed concern with the RVSB administration fees charged to process his Freedom of Information request. Mayor Livingstone replied that any request for information must follow the process that is mandated through *The Local Authority Freedom of Information & Protection of Privacy Act*. It is the Administrator who must estimate the time spent on each individual request.
