### Fire Ban

A fire ban which was implemented on July 2, 2021 is still in effect due to hot temperatures and the wind.

During a fire ban, propane or natural gas fire pits and barbeques may be used, however, fireworks and all open-air fires such as charcoal, cut seasoned wood, or manufactured fire log fires are not permitted.

### Bylaw Enforcement Reminders

Please be mindful:

- No campers/recreational vehicles (RVs) on an empty lot
- 1 licensed RV on lot with a dwelling

Properties should not have:

- a building in a ruinous or dilapidated state of repair;
- an unoccupied building that is damaged and is an imminent danger to public safety;
- land that is overgrown with grass and weeds;
- an untidy and unsightly yard;
- junked / unlicensed vehicles;
- open excavations on property.

### Pay Your Taxes at the Bank and Online

There is one more way to pay your RV of Saskatchewan Beach taxes in addition to cheque and e-Transfer!

Now you can also pay your taxes at the bank or online if you have an account at any of the following banks: Conexus Credit Union, Affinity Credit Union, Central 1 Credit Unions, Bank of Montreal, Scotia Bank, and Royal Bank of Canada.

The deadline is July 31, 2021 for the 9% discount on the 2021 municipal portion of the property taxes.

Gravelling of the roads has been done and dust proofing has been completed. This year, a liquid calcium chloride with an organic corn-based additive that provides road stabilization and corrosion inhibition benefits was applied.

The speed bumps installation has been delayed but should begin next week. Maintenance has been working hard this week clearing debris, broken trees, and branches scattered during the fierce storm on Sunday, July 10<sup>th</sup>.
