Good Neighbour Fall Cleanup

As fall cleanup proceeds please be reminded that:

- Property owners, including those with vacant lots, are responsible for keeping grass and weeds in check, ensuring they do not grow higher than 20 cm tall (8 inches). Overgrown grass can eventually dry out and become a fire hazard.
- For a limited time residents may drop off broken trees and branches at the drop-off pile just south of the Maintenance Shop located on Park Road.



- Buildings (dwelling, decks, accessory buildings, sheds) as well as fences, walls and any other structures should be maintained or removed if beyond repair.
- Debris and junk should be removed.
- No person shall exhibit, store, park, leave or place any vehicle, machinery, equipment, article, earth, stones, snow, rubbish, fences, or any other object or thing of any kind on municipal property including road allowance.

Carbon Monoxide and Smoke Alarms in Residential Buildings

The Government of Saskatchewan amended *The Uniform Building and Accessibility Standards Regulations* to require every building with a residential occupancy to have carbon monoxide (CO) and smoke alarms installed by **July 1, 2022**, regardless of the initial date of the building's construction.
