Remember to get your permit for building and renovations. A permit is required for:

- a new deck more than 1 foot off the ground
- deck structure repair such as stairs, supports, new rails
- solar panels
- accessory buildings over 100 square feet **including a shipping container/seacan**
- all additions attached to a dwelling
- installation of a pool

### Bylaw Enforcement

Beginning in May, residents may notice our Bylaw Enforcement Officer in the Village. The Officer will be checking for bylaw violations such as campers on empty lots, fences and buildings in disrepair, junked vehicles, land overgrown with grass & weeds, untidy & unsightly property, as well as dogs running at large.

### FireSmart Program



"The FireSmart Communities Program is designed to encourage self-organized groups or residents to take the lead in implementing solutions for wildfire safety on their own property."

In the past few years Saskatchewan Beach and neighbouring communities have experienced wildfires and potential wildfires that have impacted homes and property. Most wildfires are preventable.
