## Regina Sailing Club News for April 2023

As we wait patiently for the ice to leave the lake, The Regina Sailing Club (Saskatchewan Beach) is planning for the coming year. We are following a year that we hosted our first provincial regatta in over a decade, had record numbers in Mobile Sailing School, and began the process of stabilizing the club house. So how are we going to beat that?

### New (to us) Inflatable Safety Boat

Well for starters, our experience at the 2022 regatta exposed some shortcomings in our gear. The club has purchased a Seamax HD380 12.5 ft inflatable boat for use as a safety boat to support racing and recreational sailing at the club. This will enhance our ability to provide safe and prompt incident response.

### Bilge Rat Regatta July 22

This year, we are going to host a "fun" regatta that is open to all sailboats of all ages, sizes and nationalities. It is going to be a fun day with the primary goal being "fun". We would also love to see all of the older boats that have been on dry land back on the water enjoying themselves and they can bring their owners! ### Mobile Sailing School July 17 – 21
