1. **FALSE** No one council member rules. Decisions are made only when the majority of members agree at a council meeting.
2. **FALSE** Regularly scheduled Council meetings are always open to the public.
3. **TRUE** The Administrator only ensures that council's governance, policies, and directives, are carried out.
4. **FALSE** You may only appeal the property assessment when the assessment roll is open. Not the tax notice.
5. **TRUE and FALSE** Call our CAO if you have questions. Bylaws are standards to control the development and actions permitted in the municipality, creating a safe, harmonious community.
6. **TRUE** Bylaw enforcement is handed a copy of the Bylaws and they are on their way. The Village is only notified when there is a remedy required or a remedy completed.
7. **FALSE** Call the office so your request is recorded, tracked and completed. It is not maintenance's responsibility to manage these requests, unless directed from the office.
8. **FALSE** Council is governed by provincial legislation and is accountable for all decisions that are made.
9. **TRUE** Urban municipalities have very similar rules and bylaws.
10. **FALSE** It is a cost to our ratepayers. Rock is used for landscape cover and to assist with drainage erosion. Leave it where it is please.
