Every house, *this means yours*, requires a number that is visible from the street. Especially for emergencies.



Trespassing Awareness

Trespass is a wrongful entry on real property. When out walking, bike riding, golf carting or driving your ATV, be aware of public property and private property. In Saskatchewan Beach many owners have large treed properties and may look like public parks and hiking trails. Public areas in Saskatchewan Beach, where the general public may enter on foot are: The Disc Golf course, West Beach park area, Main Beach park area. Golf carts and ATVs are permitted only on public roads, lanes and parking lots. A driveway entrance is not for public use it is private property and if you are on it you are trespassing. Respect the private property and do not enter signs.
