- ✓ **Bylaw #1/2023** Pets must be leashed and under control of the pet owner at all times. Please pick up after your pet.
- ✓ **Bylaw #53** Residents must have a house number posted and it must be visible from the street.
- ✓ **Bylaw #9/2023** Development Permits are required for all projects. Development permits are not Building Permits. Doing work without a permit may result in higher fees.
- ✓ **Property taxes are due December 31, 2025.** Payment can be made through your online banking bill payments (use your roll number as your account number when setting this up), debit, cheque or cash.

Outdoor Storage of Materials

Bylaw 171, Section 15:
Any building materials, lumber, scrap metal, boxes or similar items stored in a yard shall be neatly stacked in piles and elevated off the ground so as not to constitute a nuisance or harborage for rodents, vermin and insects.

Bylaw 171, Section 16:
Materials referred to in Section 15 shall be at least 0.15 metres (5 inches) off the ground and shall be stacked at least 3.0 metres (10 feet) from exterior walls of any building and at least 1.0 metres (3 feet) from the property line.

remove them within 48 hours.*
