Things to know.....



The Beach washrooms will be open May long weekend (weather dependent)

The boat launch gate will be locked after the May long weekend



Leashed pets are allowed at the east end of West Beach. Pets are not permitted at the Main Beach or in the swimming area at the West Beach.

Development permits are required for:

- ✓ All structural changes to a building.
- ✓ A maximum of 3 accessory buildings under 100 Square feet are permitted. Any additional accessory buildings will require a permit.
- ✓ Septic or holding tank installation.
- ✓ Retaining walls over 2 feet tall.
- ✓ Excavation, filling or land clearing.

A Development Permit AND a Building permit is required for all structural changes.
