## SASKATCHEWAN BEACH IS DEDICATED TO SAVING LIVES

Saskatchewan Beach has a publicly accessible AED. This life saving machine is located on the east side of the Village Office and is visible from Lakeview Avenue. The green weather proof cabinet is secured with a tear away safety seal and video camera. When the cabinet door is opened an alarm sounds, the purpose of the alarm is to attract additional attention. The alarm will stop when the cabinet door is closed. The Automated External Defibrillator (AED) is in the red case inside the cabinet. This HeartStart Defibrillator gives verbal instructions to help. In case of an emergency call 911 immediately.



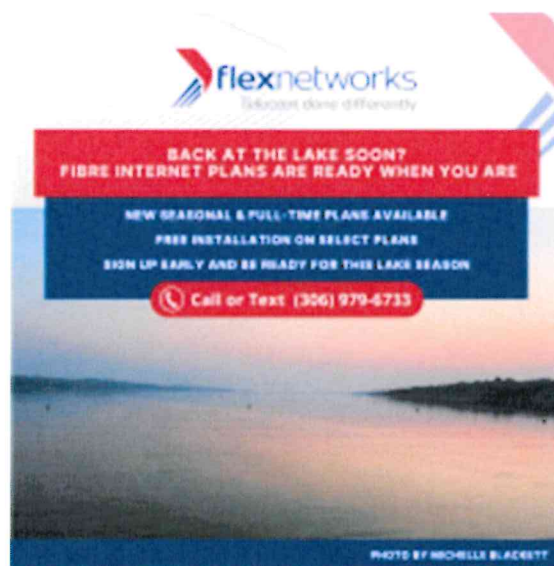
## COMMUNITIES IN BLOOM

**Bylaw #53**

**Civic Addressing  
Bylaw**

Every house, *this means yours*, requires a number that is visible from the street. Especially for emergencies.



*Leashed pets are permitted at the West Beach east of the swimming area.*



Fish guts are not permitted in the public garbage cans.

**THE BYLAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER WILL BE FOCUSING ON THESE ITEMS UNDER BYLAW 134 THE NUISANCE ABATEMENT BYLAW.**

**Junked Vehicle** – means an automobile, tractor, truck, trailer or other vehicle that: either has no valid license plates attached to it or is in a rusted, wrecked, partly wrecked, dismantled, partly dismantled, inoperative or abandoned condition; and is located on private land.

**Nuisance** – means a condition of property, or a thing or an activity that adversely affects or may adversely affect the safety, health or welfare of people, people’s use and enjoyment or their property, or the attractiveness of the municipality and includes:

- (1) A building in a ruinous or dilapidated state of repair;
- (2) An unoccupied building that is damaged and is an imminent danger to public safety;
- (3) Land that is overgrown with grass and weeds;
- (4) Untidy and unsightly property;
- (5) Junked vehicles; and
- (6) Open excavations on property.

No person shall cause or permit any of the above items to occur.

**Outdoor storage of materials** – the owner of any property shall ensure that any building materials, lumber, scrap metal, boxes or similar items stored on the property are neatly stacked in piles as follows:

- (1) Elevated at least 0.15 metres off the ground;
- (2) At least 3.0 metres from the exterior walls of any building; and
- (3) At least 1.0 metres from the property line.

the owner of any property shall ensure that all hinges, latches, lid, door or doors are removed from any refrigerator or freezers on the property.

**Fences** – the owner of any property shall ensure that all fences are maintained in a safe and reasonable state of repair.

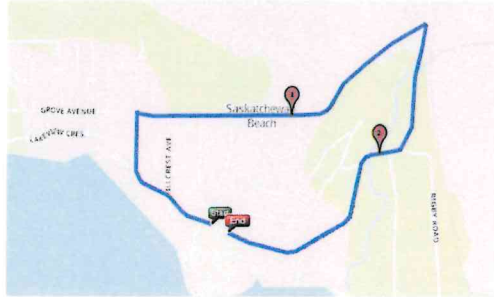
