If you are doing any of the following you need a Development Permit.

- Excavation, earthwork adding or removing soil.
- Maximum is 3 sheds under 100 square feet. Any more requires a permit.
- A Development Permit must be approved before a Building Permit is approved.

What is a Permit for Operation of Lug Vehicles?

Definition of Lug Vehicle – means any vehicle, portable engine or traction engine having metal spikes, lugs or cleats projecting from the face of the wheels or having a metal track thread.

If your project requires the use of such heavy machinery either by yourself or contractor a Permit to Operate a Lug Vehicle is required. The purpose of this permit is to make the Village aware of the vehicle and to remind the operator that efforts need to be made to protect the roads. This can be by unloading and loading the equipment on the property using it, laying rubber tires or wood to protect the roads the equipment is travelling on to get to the project site. Costs to repair road damage may be charged to the contractor or property owner. There is no fee for this permit.
